**DEVELOPMENT & PEACE:** In another part of the global south in Guatemala, Bishop Alvaro Ramazzini defends the indigenous Sipakapa community's right to say no to mining. He is concerned about the potential dangers to the health of the land, water and people from the mining operations of Canadian – U.S. Transnational Company. The Sipakapa community held a consultation process where, overwhelmingly, it voted "NO" to mining. Despite this clear objection from the community and the objections from the Guatemalan Bishop, mining continues.
